A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF LFYORD, TX, COMMITTING LOCAL FUNDS TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CDBG CARES OR CDBG-CV) COMMUNITY RESILIENCY PROGRAM (CRP) CONTRACT NUMBER 70800001005

WHEREAS, the City of Lyford, TX, shall utilize CDBG-CV grant funds for the construction of a new public facility, known as the Lyford Resiliency Center, which is designed to prevent, prepare for, and respond to pandemics as related to the COVID-19 or any of its variants as well as mitigation for all future pandemics; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid for the project as well as all associated project costs, exceed the budgeted amount of funds available for construction as evidenced by Amended Exhibit D, Project Budget (attached); and

WHEREAS, to construct the project given the amount of TDHCA grant funds available, it is in the best interest of the health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lyford to commit to provide non-CDBG local funds from the City of Lyford General Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That the City of Lyford shall contribute unrestricted local funds in the amount of \$50,017.31 for the construction and completion of CDBG-CV Contract Number 70800001005. These funds will be an unencumbered contribution to the project by the City of Lyford.

Dear Mr. Salazar:

The City of Lyford is respectfully requesting a 12-month contract extension to December 31, 2025 for the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs FY 2020 Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CDBG CARES" or CDBG-CV") Contract No. 70800001005. The current contract term is December 20, 2022 through December 20, 2024.

The amendment request is for an extension of the original contract end date, December 20, 2024, as well as a final project budget adjustment. The reason for the extension request is that bids were opened for the project three times, with the first two bid openings considerably exceeding the funds available to construct the project. All bids were rejected, and the project architect redesigned the building following each bid opening, reducing the size and scope of the project. The low bid in the third bid opening on July 31, 2024, was still above the project funds available but through Contract Change Order #1, brought it to a more financially manageable project that the City can afford.

The first bid opening was held on September 14, 2023. The redesign, review, approval and rebidding two more times took up almost a year of the TDHCA two-year contract period.

Attached you will find the final Exhibit D (Amended) and the Exhibit A, with proposed, amended project milestones.
