



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING YOUR BRUSH / BULKY ITEM SERVICE

Once per month, (see schedule below), you will receive a brush /bulky item pick-up for a total of 12 collections per year. **Please keep brush free of debris listed below under items not collected. Keep brush in a separate pile from bulky items (see below). Note: Brush must not exceed 8 feet in length.**

<b>Important Note: Please be sure to have your brush/bulky items at the curb and ready for pick-up <u>PRIOR</u> to your scheduled week listed below. Truck will only make one pass and cannot return for late set outs. If we have serviced your area, please do not set out any late brush/bulky items. They will not be serviced until following month!</b>		

### **IMPORTANT SERVICE GUIDELINES**

Please do not place items within 6 feet of any obstacles such as gas or water meters, telephone service boxes, overhead wires of any kind, parked cars, building overhangs, etc... In order to help achieve recycling goals please place your brush and bulky items in separate piles. Place brush/bulky items at the curb instead of the alley whenever possible to avoid access problems. If you should require a second cart, contact City Hall at 347-3512.
