3. Armando Ramirez: request for clean up of the city's 40' Road right of way on Gulf and behind his Outlots 87,88,89. City to look into it. Republic Services will not pick up any brush/debris on empty lots unless a dwelling is on it.
4. Gilbert Sada: petition to re-open El Toro Gameroom. Mr. Sada was supposed to meet with city attorney Robert Flores, but Mr. Flores took sick.
5. Jerry Vassberg: Commissioner Salinas made the motion to have Vassberg continue paying the monthly bill until the city comes up with a reason for the high usage. Commissioner Quilantan seconded. All approved and motion carried.

6. TxCDBG-Contract #7218018 Health Clinic: Commissioner Chavez made the motion to approve Change Order #1 in the amount of \$116,207.50 (\$675,000-116,207.50=\$558,792.50). Commissioner Salinas seconded. All approved and motion carried.
7. Discussed the Health Clinic construction permit. City to meet with Fire Marshall Oscar Gutierrez and Code Enforcer Andres Chavez regarding the fire hydrant on FM 498. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to table until such time. Commissioner Quilantan seconded. All approved and motion carried.
8. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to approve pay application to Cornett Construction in the amount of \$44,539.12 for substantial completion of sanitary sewer extension along Glen Lofton Avenue. Commissioner Mireles seconded. All approved and motion carried.
9. Discuss the Lyford Outlots 87-89 for Armando Ramirez: it is the recommendation of the city engineer to release construction permit only if the property purchased is platted in accordance

with city ordinance. Commissioner Cavazos made the motion to have Armando Ramirez follow Subdivision Rules and plat property purchased (Lyford Outlots 87-89). Commissioner Mireles seconded. All approved and motion carried.

10. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to approve to hold the Christmas Festivities on Saturday, December 7, 2019; approved to allow to spend not to exceed \$2,800.00 for the Christmas Festival. Commissioner Chavez seconded. All approved and motion carried
11. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to approve the Resolution and TxDot Temporary Closure of Road Agreement for the Christmas Parade on December 7, 2019. Commissioner Chavez Seconded. All approved and motion carried.
12. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to approve to attend the Corpus Christi Police impound auction and allow to spend \$6,000 from the Capital Improvement Fund. Commissioner Cavazos seconded. All approved and motion carried.
13. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to change payroll from biweekly to weekly starting in December, 2019. Commissioner Quilantan seconded. All approved and motion carried.
14. Commissioner Salinas made the motion to purchase Thanksgiving Turkeys/hams. Commissioner Quilantan seconded. All approved and motion carried.
15. Commissioner Chavez made the motion to approve the utility billing through 10/31/2019. Commissioner Quilantan seconded. All approved and motion carried.
